Exciting Full Dance Schedule

May 31: Long Dance

It is an ancient ritual that is danced at night. The Long Dance is a powerful vehicle of change. Your intention provides the power, nature & direction of the Dance. The dance brings to conscious levels of awareness the vibrational essences that make up God's perceptual realities.

July 4: Sun Moon Dance

The four days of the Sun Moon Dance bring many teachings. The dance arbor is the sacred Medicine Wheel, and represents the world and the life it contains and nurtures. Through willingness to invest effort, seekers receive inspiration to live a life of greater spiritual awareness. In the dance, we work to bring

in the directional energies of the east, south, west, north, up above, and down below. The web of energy created by the dancers transforms the land, and permeates the world to bring healing.

Aug. 29: Drum Dance

The three day Drum Dance is an opportunity to heal lineage for 7 generations both past and future. The dancers move rhythmically on their path towards "truth" represented by hanging feathers. The dancers dance the vibration of sound, bouncing back (past) and forth (future), returning to present memory. Resonating vibration of sound shifts consciousness because the energies want to dance effortlessly between the present and future in harmony.

Aug. 1: Hochaka Dance

Hochaka is the Lakota people's word for a sacred altar or circle. Join us in creating an altar, a sacred circle to build a spiritual family. We support each other in prayer and ceremony. We will dance to our own beat of rattles and whistles. We will dance to the tree of Life. There is no drum. There is no crew, only the vibration of the group. We are collectively everything that is needed. We create through dance our commitment to the Hochaka.

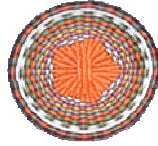

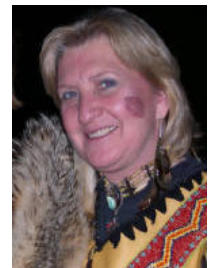


Women's Initiation into Womanhood Ceremony "Rites of Passage" August 8-10

Chief Red Cloud and other elders gave him the honor of being the Sun Dance Chief of the Oglala Lakota (Sioux). He is a Sun Dance leader, a medicine man, and one of the most caring two legged you could ever meet. He also has a sense of humor that will keep you on your toes.

Steve lives on the Pine Ridge Reservation which is one of the most poverty stricken areas in our country. Like his father, he sees himself as a common man and an instrument of the Creator.

On Friday night, we will be holding an evening to enjoy the humor, the culture and the deep wisdom that lives with-in this incredible man. He says visit because he wants to hear and get to know you also.

Saturday we will continue the visit. Bring food to share and a heart to hear the wisdom. Later in the day? sometime? Indian time? we will join in an inipi (sweat lodge) ceremony. As Steve says, "Spirit has no time so don't put me on a schedule".

Zoe has over 20 years experience making fans and has many tricks and techniques to make a beautiful and strong fan. Her initial training to make fans came from an Shawnee elder who was one of the leading fan makers in the country. She takes great care and love in crafting each one. Her fans have been commissioned by people all over the world. You will learn her trade secrets!

The Basis Class ... Student will make a smudge fan in order to learn all the basic steps to take home and apply to own creations. (limit - 8 students)

Creative Class ... In this class, students will work ,using their own feathers, to design a special creation with Zoe's expert guidance. (limit - 4 students)

The Foundation For Earth's Ancestral Voices is a Federal Tax Exempt Organization which maintains the Peace Chamber.

The Earth Center, home of Earth's Ancestral Voices (EAV), sits on 8 acres of land surrounded by an additional 40 acres of privately owned land in the Blue Ridge Mountains of North Carolina. It is located in Swannanoa, just outside of Asheville. The main focal point is an acoustical 36 X 24 foot elliptical dome, which is 18 feet high in the center. The Swannanoa Peace

Chamber is the 18th chamber and started construction in 1990. There are over 60 chambers scattered around the world. The Chamber vision is one of Pueblo Ute Shaman named Joseph Rael. The United Nation supports this project due to its unilateral contribution towards peace on the planet.

Funds are needed for maintenance of power, road, land taxes, and port-a-john. Also there are projects to beautify and make the chamber more accessible we wish to accomplish.

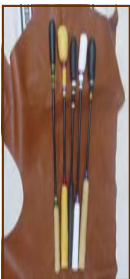
